## Course Format Descriptions

- **Hybrid** – Course uses a combination of in-person and online instruction, with most of the instruction being conducted online. All students attend in-person instruction together during the scheduled class time. The balance of the course is conducted online at no scheduled time.
- **In Person (IP)** – All instruction is in person on campus in a classroom with a specified meeting time. The instructor may also use the online Canvas course shell for assignments and/or readings and other course materials.
- **Online Asynchronous** – Course is conducted online at no scheduled time. All instruction is fully online including discussions, activities, group work and peer interaction. Online courses carry a \$100 online course fee.

## Internship, Capstone, and Thesis

- **CRJU 6910 Field Study in Criminal Justice** – Internship may be taken in the fall, spring, or summer term.
- **CRJU 5361 Capstone Seminar** – Capstone is offered in the fall and spring terms, and accommodates both in person and online students.
- **CRJU 6950 Master's Thesis** – Thesis is generally available in the fall and spring terms, and may be available in the summer term based on thesis committee availability.

While the MCJ program makes every effort to offer courses according to the above rotation, course offerings are subject to change due to demand and staffing.
